

Nurture Day Nurseries Fee Structure: For Parents / Carers

Nurture Day Nurseries Fees as at 1st June 2018

Fees for children under 3 years old are £78.00 per day

Fees for children over 3 years old are £72.00 per day. This will be reduced subject to your child's nursery education funding.

The nursery is open 52 weeks of the year except bank holidays.

Nurture Day Nurseries fees are calculated monthly and invoiced in the prior month.

We operate a calendar monthly system using actual days in a given month. The monthly figures below are an approximate for an average month.

No refunds are available for bank holidays, sickness and family vacations.

Nurture Day Nurseries provide full-day childcare sessions. These sessions are available in blocks of consecutive 2 days, 3 days or 5 days. There is also the option for 2x 2days to make a 4-day week possible.

Nursery Fees for Children Over 3 Years Old

When your child turns three years old, the over 3 year old rate will become applicable, one month after their 3rd birthday.

All children over 3 years old are entitled to a maximum of 15 hours of nursery education funding (NEF) for 38 weeks of the year. This applies until they reach compulsory school age (the term following their fifth birthday).

Your child is eligible for the over 3 year old rate and the nursery education funding fee rate when they are:

- 3 years old by 31 March, they will be eligible from 1st April (Summer Term)
- 3 years old by 31 August, they will be eligible from 1st September (Autumn Term)
- 3 years old by 31 December, they will be eligible from 1st January (Spring Term)

Above are official cut-off dates. Therefore if your child's birthday, for example, is on 1st January and the new term started on 5th January, their funding will not start until the Summer Term because they have passed the cut-off date of 31st December.

If your child attends another nursery and is offering you 15 hours of the nursery education funding, then we can discuss funding options and what is available to you. If the child only attends Nurture Day Nurseries then we will manage the nursery education funding process.

Incorporating the Government Nursery Education Funding Into the Monthly Fee:

The nursery education funding entitlement is for 38 weeks; however our fees are calculated per calendar month. The invoice will detail what elements are eligible for the Nursery Education Funding and will ensure each family still receives their correct 38 week entitlement.

We can discuss your individual fee structure during the registration and enrolment process.

Childcare Vouchers:

Nurture Day Nurseries Ltd are affiliated to and accept most of the Childcare Voucher Schemes offered by employers.

Before informing your childcare voucher provider of our details, ask us for our membership number as we might already be registered with that company and it will save duplicate accounts being setup.

Fees are to be paid by the 28th day of every month; this covers the child care for the following month.
